Developing Tactical Handling and Marksmanship Skills

Price: \$1150.00 total; includes the Colt Canada C8 Operator-Instructor course offered in combination with the MilCun Police Tactical Rifle Marksmanship course. This 4-day course includes instruction, classroom, lunches, ranges, targets and support staff as required.

Pre-requisites: For C8A2 Operator portion, students will require Colt Canada equipment. If your agency does not have such equipment, let us know and we will try to make appropriate equipment available. For the Tactical Marksmanship portion, students must have completed the Operator course for the weapon they intend to use during the course. Each student is required to bring a **minimum of 750 rounds** of ammunition.

The aim of this course is to develop your handling and marksmanship skills with your Colt Canada tactical rifle or carbine. The course includes:
